# Cone Health nears completion of new primary care office in Triad

Cone Health will open a new primary care office in the Triad in the next few weeks, just as a Boston-based health care provider prepares to open three primary care facilities in the Triad.

The 5,600-square-foot Cone Health location will open Oct. 1 at Elmsley Square in south Greensboro, according to Cone Health spokesman [Doug Allred](#). Three staffers, including an advance practice provider, will work there. The space was formerly occupied by Hollywood Video.

Allred said a 1,500-square-foot urgent care center in a storefront next door will open later.

"We haven't set the date, and are still lining up staffing," he said.

As of Friday, Allred said the practice had yet to be named.

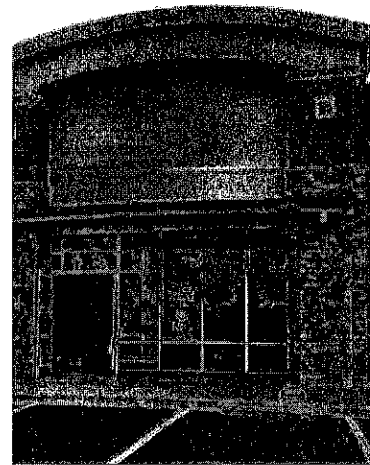
Elmsley Square is on South Elm-Eugene Street, just northwest of Interstate 85 Bypass. Area stores include Super Walmart (NYSE: WMT) and Lowe's Home Improvement (NYSE: LOW).

[IORA Primary Care is scheduled to open this month at Westridge Square in Greensboro.](#) Other IORA locations at 3274 Silas Creek Pkwy. in Winston-Salem, and at 274 Eastchester Drive in High Point are scheduled to open Sept. 30.

In March 2018, Triad Business Journal reported that Cone affiliate [LeBauer HealthCare](#) would open a 12,000-square-foot medical practice with sports medicine, behavioral health and primary care services near the Publix under construction at [Grandover Village](#), which is at the intersection of [Guilford College Road](#) and West Gate City Boulevard.

[LeBauer Health Care at Horse Pen Creek](#), a medical practice similar to the Grandover facility, opened in north Greensboro in early 2018.
